

SAP CPQ and Salesforce CRM integration adapter Installation Guide

SAP CPQ component ‘SAP CPQ integration with Salesforce solutions by Clarity Labs’ is a .NET add-on to SAP CPQ following the rules in SAP CPQ extension guide and can be deployed using the standard deployment tools provided by SAP CPQ.

Partner product name is ‘SAP CPQ and Salesforce CRM integration adapter’.

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1. Download the package from:


Software was handed over to cloud operations and accessible through cloud operations.

- 2.1. Enter SAP CPQ link in your browser (e.g. <https://cpq-sales.calliduscloud.com/>)
- 2.2. Enter your: Username, Password and Tenant Domain (e.g. `se_custom_demo_03`)
- 2.3. Press Login





3. Upload the package


3.1. Press gear icon on the left vertical toolbar


