In scorecard components, text can be set to wrap within cells.

In bubble charts, alerts can be based on any data range in the Excel spreadsheet. Alerts can also be based on X values, Y values, and bubble sizesfrom the chart.

Exclude hyperlinks from export

- 2. Select one of the above format options and then click **OK**.
- Click Remove Hyperlink.
- 4. Click OK.

In the "Edit Parameter" dialog box, under "Value Options", you can now choose to use "Show Value" or "Show Description" in the "Show Value or Description" option.

PDF export on the BI platform now supports Arabic and Hebrew languages

When using SAP BusinessObjects Business Intelligence platform on AIX, Linux, or Solaris, Crystal Reports PDF exporting now supports Arabic and Hebrew (right to left) languages.

SAP HANA 1.0 SP2 (ODBC and JDBC) is a supported report data source

All HANA views are supported, including Column, Analytical, and Attribute views.


